Coach Bios

Coach Tom O'Connell was the first high school coach ever elected President of the American

baseball, including 31 years at Pulaski High School in Milwaukee where his teams won more games than any sport in the school's history. He has been an envoy coach for ISG Baseball for 20 years, taking him throughout the world, including Germany where he was lead Envoy Coach for MLB and scout for the Dodgers,

Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA). He recently retired after 51 years of coaching

baseball books, including one of the top selling handbooks "Coaching Baseball:

Reds, Phillies and Orioles. He is President of ISG Baseball and author of three

Techniques and Tactics".

Coach Brent Strom is a former Major League Baseball (MLB) pitcher with New York Mets, Cleveland

and San Diego and current pitching coach for the Arizona Diamondbacks. He previously coached at major league organizations Houston Astros, KC Royal's and St. Louis Cardinal's. He has close to 40 years of coaching experience, including minor league coaching with the LA Dodgers, San Diego, and Montreal/Washington organizations. He holds the distinction of being just the second person ever to have Tommy John surgery. He is a member of the ISG Baseball for 17 years.

Coach John Casey is one of the most respected leaders in college baseball. He is currently pitching coach at Johnson & Wales University and formally he was head coach at Tufts

University for 38 years, one of the best teams in New England. Former President and Hall of Fame inductee at the American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA), he has coached many players who have gone on to play Major League Baseball.
