Overview

The overall aim of the Academy programme is to develop a National Team squad at all age levels. A group of up to 20 players per age group will be selected at the beginning of each season to benefit from over 40 dedicated sessions of individual and group trainings, as well as games. Typically, the Academy will run over a period of 11 months, from November to September each year. Academy players are expected to participate in the majority of training sessions to be considered for National Team selection.

Programme Phases

The 2024-25 Academy season will commence in November 2024 for all age groups. The Academy will be run in a number of phases:

- Phase 1 (November) introduction
- Phase 2 (December Apr) development work
- Phase 3 (May August) game practise and tournaments
- Phase 4 (September) review and 2024-25 development planning

* The squad of 20 players per age group will be selected by head coaches for each age group.



Weekly time slots for each age group will be as follows:

- U12 Saturday, 10 to 12 noon
- U15 Wednesday, 6 to 8pm & Saturday, 12 to 2pm
- U18 Tuesday & Thursday, 6 to 8pm
- Senior Tuesday & Thursday, 8 to 10pm

Eligibility

For European and other tournaments each player must be aged 12, 15, 18 respectively, or under, **for the year of the tournament**. The following age ranges apply for the 2024-25 Academy squads.*

- U12 Birth year 2013, 2014, 2015 (i.e. turning 10, 11 or 12 in 2025)
- U15 Birth year 2010, 2011, 2012 (i.e. turning 13, 14 or 15 in 2025)
- U18 Birth year 2007, 2008, 2009 (i.e. turning 16, 17 or 18 in 2025)

* In exceptional circumstances, a player younger than the age category may participate based on playing ability. The head coach for the age, in consultation with other coaches, will have final decision on player selection.

All players require an Irish passport to be considered for the National Team but not to participate in the Academy and Academy competitions.

Costs

The cost for the academy 11-month academy programme in Strike Zone is as follows:

- U12 €300
- U15 €450
- U18 €600 (includes access to gym)
- Senior €600 (includes access to gym)
