
Irish Baseball Academy

Programme Details - Timings

Phase 1 weekly training times (Nov to Apr)

- U12 Saturday 10 to 12noon
- U15 Wednesday 6 to 8pm, Saturday, 12 to 2pm
- U18 Tuesday & Thursday 6 to 8pm, Saturday 2 to 4pm
- U23/Senior Tuesday & Thursday 8 to 10pm, Saturday/Sunday (TBC)

Phase 2 weekly training times (May to Sept)

- More detailed plans to be finalised during the year
- Times of training may vary, subject to outdoor training and game plans
- Groups may take time off for holidays and down time between July and August





Programme Details - Eligibility

For European and other tournaments each player must be aged 12, 15, 18 respectively, or under, for the year of the tournament. The following age ranges apply for the 2025-26 Academy groups.*

- U12 Birth year 2014, 2015, 2016 (i.e. turning 10, 11 or 12 in 2026)
- U15 Birth year 2011, 2012, 2013 (i.e. turning 13, 14 or 15 in 2026)
- U18 Birth year 2008, 2009, 2010 (i.e. turning 16, 17 or 18 in 2026)
- * In exceptional circumstances, a player younger than the age category may participate based on playing ability. The coach lead for the group, in consultation with other coaches, will have the final decision on player selection.





Programme Details - Costs

The cost for the 2025-26 academy programme in Strike Zone is as follows.

- U12 €300
- U15 €450
- U18 €600 (includes access to gym)
- U23/Senior €600 (includes access to gym)

4a. Central Support Team

- Player Registration & Payments Manage online sign-ups and payment tracking.
- Coach training & Vetting Work with Child Safety Officer to ensure all coaches trained and vetted to appropriate level
- Facilities Monitor and maintain cleanliness and maintenance requirements of facility
- Uniform & Equipment Coordination Manage inventory, place orders and coordinate distribution.
- Fundraising & Sponsorship Manage Academy specific fundraising campaigns.
- Social Media & Communications Maintain central updates on Academy events, tournament results and key announcements.
- Tournament & Travel Logistics Support and advise specific groups on flights, hotels, transport, etc..
- Central Calendar Maintain the master schedule of events for the year sharing with all coaches and parents as needed.



4b. Group Specific Support Team

- Parent Liaison Act as primary contact point with parents, sharing weekly updates, training times and upcoming events.
- Attendance & Payment Ensure all academy members are registered and payments completed.
- Fundraising & Sponsorship Support central fundraising campaigns by engaging with their parent group.
- Games/Tournaments Make travel arrangements, player forms and match-day logistics for their specific groups.
- Media & Photography Capture team photos, videos and match highlights for use by the central comms team.
